

• This Protocol makes it easier for African businesses and professionals to offer services like transport, tourism, IT, banking and education - across borders.


Fewer restrictions for service providers

More business opportunities in new countries




• If you sell a service (not a physical product), this Protocol helps you expand across Africa without complicated rules or needing to open a physical office in every country!




♦ HOW DOES IT WORK?

Very features of the Protocol:

- ✓ Market Access Countries agree to reduce or remove restrictions on service sectors (e.g., no limits on number of foreign firms).
- ✓ National Treatment You'll be treated the same as local providers in other African countries who are Members of the AfCFTA.
- ✓ Mutual Recognition Your qualifications (e.g., degrees, licenses) may be recognised in other countries.
- √ Transparency Clear, public rules so you know what's required to operate.


